

ORDINANCE NO. 883

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING ELECTRICAL RATES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF OBERLIN,
KANSAS, that:

Section One: The rate for electric current supplied by the city shall be at the rate of \$0.1355 per kilowatt hour with all customers paying an additional demand charge of \$7.00 per residential meter and \$12.00 per month per non-residential meter.

Section Two: These rates shall be effective for billings occurring on and after December 31, 2015 which includes usage during part of December 2015 and January 2016.

Section Three: All ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section Four: This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its publication in the official city newspaper.
